Subject: EU terrorist list

The citizens of the European Union received the news in mid-December that the Palestinian terror organisation Hamas has been deleted from the list of terrorist organisations kept by the European Union as the result of a procedural error. The question of whether or not the Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK) should remain on the list is under discussion. At the same time, a growing number of militias in Africa, such as the al-Shabab militia, are fighting against national armies and have declared their loyalty to Al-Qaeda (which is also on the list).

- 1. What changes to the list of terrorist organisations have been made since 2000?
- 2. On what grounds were organisations deleted or added over that period?
- 3. What groups does the Council think may be included on the list in future, and what groups are currently being discussed in the Council with a view to inclusion on the list?
