Subject: Redundancies at Air France

According to reports which appeared in the press on 14 January 2015, Air France may be about to make another 5000 employees redundant; it has already cut its workforce by 8000 following the introduction, in 2012, of its 'Transform 2015' plan.

On 2 December 2014 the European Parliament approved the Commission's proposal to award 3886 workers made redundant by Air France EUR 25 million in assistance from the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund - the largest single amount ever paid out from the Fund. A total of 5213 Air France employees have lost their jobs as a result of the implementation of the 'Transform 2015' plan.

- 1. Is the Commission aware of this new wave of redundancies at Air France?
- 2. Has the Commission granted aid to Air France, despite the fact that the 'Transform 2015' plan has cost thousands of workers their jobs?
