Subject: Declaration of Famagusta

On 14 February 2012, Parliament adopted a declaration on the return of the sealed-off area of Famagusta to its lawful inhabitants. The declaration calls on the Government of Turkey to act in accordance with Resolutions 550 (1984) and 789 (1992) of the UN Security Council and with relevant report recommendations given by the European Parliament, and to return the sealed-off Famagusta area to its lawful inhabitants, who must be allowed to resettle under conditions of security and peace.

How has the Commission utilised the aforementioned declaration on Famagusta to enforce Turkey to respect the resolutions and recommendations?
