Subject: Fomenting competition in the distribution of motor fuels

With a view to preventing large-scale operators from taking unfair advantage of their dominant positions in the sector and acting contrary to effective competition, and also with a view to opening markets up and fomenting competition, so as to lower prices and so that both consumers and businesses pay less, does the Commission plan to adopt any measures for promoting greater effective competition in the distribution of motor fuels to filling stations, such as reducing the large-scale operators' market share and/or impeding exclusive supply contracts?
