Subject: Food waste

The subject of food waste is very much in the news. According to data released in the report, *Food wastage footprint: Impacts on natural resources*, published by the FAO's Natural Resources Management and Environment Department in 2013, food waste is responsible for the emission of 3.3 billion tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> a year. The loss of land, water and biodiversity attributable to food waste, plus the negative impact it has on climate change, represent a high cost for the whole of society that has yet to be properly quantified.
