Subject: Agricultural exports

Recently released figures show that agriculture exports rose by 1.7 % between August and November 2014, which is highly encouraging given the effects of the Russian ban on EU food.

Is this growth likely to continue over the next quarter, or are the figures expected to stabilise?

Could the Commission give an estimate as to what the export figures would have been had there not been a Russian ban on EU food?
