Subject: EU funding and earthquakes in Emilia-Romagna

In view of:

- the sum of EUR 563 million allocated from the European Union Solidarity Fund to the Emilia-Romagna Region in order to help it recover following the earthquakes of 20 and 29 May 2012;
- the official communication of 12 December 2013 in which the Region declared that it had spent every last cent of that funding and that ‘the 100 % reporting objective has been fully met’;
- the update from the authors stating that this reporting has never been fully disclosed to the public;
- the Aemilia investigation (coordinated by the Regional Anti-Mafia Public Prosecutor’s Office of Bologna, which led to 117 arrests, and a further 46 by the Public Prosecutor’s Offices of Catanzaro and Brescia), which uncovered strong associations between politicians, businessmen and organised criminals in Emilia-Romagna;
- the fact that several companies embroiled in the investigation were involved in the reconstruction of buildings and roads destroyed by the earthquakes;

Can the Commission please reveal:

- whether it would be possible to publish a list of every single project, individual and company that received the EUR 563 million from the EUSF?
- whether any of those recipients has or could potentially have links with the people arrested in the Aemilia investigation?
