Subject: Booking flights: different device, different price

When booking a flight, searching again for the same flight can result in considerable price fluctuations of up to 40%.

Furthermore, prices for bookings have also been found to vary depending on the end device. The price reached via an app can turn out to be different to that reached via a computer or by telephone. Price development is inexplicable and irritates consumers. It is in violation of a judgment of the European Court of Justice.

These ambiguities give rise to the following questions:

1. Is the Commission aware of the situation referred to above?
2. Does the Commission believe that action is required to make these practices transparent for the consumers again?
3. If so, how does the Commission intend to proceed?
