Subject: The Ukrainian humanitarian crisis

The Ukrainian crisis has resulted, on the whole, in a large-scale humanitarian tragedy. According to the latest data it is believed that 921 640 people have been displaced within Ukraine, more than 600 000 people have sought refuge in neighbouring countries, and about 5.2 million people live in the war zone. This tragedy is in many ways reminiscent of the Balkan tragedy of the nineties, which has not yet healed.

Has the Commission, in cooperation with Member States, prepared a long-term strategy of care for people affected by the Ukrainian war and humanitarian crisis?
