Subject: Response to the European Parliament resolution on human rights in Sudan

During the plenary session of 17 July 2014, the European Parliament adopted a joint resolution concerning the case of the Sudanese woman Meriam Yahia Ibrahim. The daughter of an Ethiopian Christian mother and a Sudanese Muslim father, Ms Ibrahim was raised as a Christian and married a Christian man, as a consequence of which her father's side of the family accused her of adultery, for which she was imprisoned and sentenced to death. The resolution committed the European Union to playing a leadership role in pushing for a strong resolution on Sudan at the Human Rights Council session in September 2014.

Can the Commission comment on the outcome of this meeting and on any recent measures that it has adopted to strengthen its efforts to protect human rights in Sudan?
