Subject: Fraud involving European funds in training courses in Galicia

It its Answer to my Written Question E-008313/2014, the Commission said it is aware of the Spanish authorities' ongoing investigation into training courses in the Galicia Region financed by European funds.

The Commission gave details of the action it has taken, including the fact that it has informed OLAF, and said that 'as of 10 December 2014 no official reply has been received from the national authorities on this case. Upon the reception of the requested information and depending of the facts that are transmitted the Commission might start its own investigation on this case'.

Given the time that has elapsed, could the Commission state what progress has been made with the investigations it launched and whether the Spanish authorities have already sent the 'requested information', and if so, what this information entails and what action the Commission is going to take on it?
