Subject: Isis threat to Sicily

An Isis document entitled 'The Islamic State 2015' calls for an attack on Sicily. The document apparently states that, 'if al-Qa'ida in the Islamic Maghreb were to launch missiles from the Tunisian coast towards Italy, they could reach it'.

There are very real grounds for concern, and the situation clearly needs to be investigated, as threats contained in Isis documents must not be under-estimated.

Is the Commission looking into a prevention plan that could be implemented should Isis forces reach or infiltrate the North African coast?
