Question for written answer E-003224/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Lidia Senra Rodríguez (GUE/NGL)

Subject: Food labelling - Parliament resolution and reports

In its answer to Written Questions E-009209/2014, E-006052/2014 and E-007653/2014, the Commission stated that it would be submitting a report to Parliament and the Council in December 2014 regarding the possibility of extending mandatory origin labelling with respect to certain foods, in particular for single-ingredient products and ingredients that represent more than 50% of a food.

Nevertheless, this report has not yet been submitted and in the meantime Parliament has adopted resolution P8\_TA(2015)0034, in which it 'urges the Commission to follow up its report with legislative proposals making the indication of the origin of meat in processed foods mandatory'.

- 1. Will the Commission draw up this report and include an obligation for the label to show the country of origin of mussels and fish in processed and preserved fish products?
- 2. Will it act on the proposal recently approved by Parliament regarding the obligation to indicate the origin of meat in processed foods?
