Subject: ISIL

In recent weeks we have been faced in recent weeks with a variety of serious threats and, indeed, specific crimes by members of the so-called ISIL against innocent people. The latest in a series of serious crimes took place in Libya, on the shores of the Mediterranean, and was accompanied by threats to EU citizens.

Serious threats are directed at Italy, which is facing a refugee crisis as one of the EU coastlines closest to Libya. For these reasons I ask the Commission:

Since the existing measures have proved ineffective, what urgent new measures is the EU planning to take to protect its borders and citizens, given the threat to Italy and a potential threat to Malta as the Member closest to the territories from which the threats were sent?
