Subject: Humanitarian aid in Syria

Taking into consideration that over 12.2 million Syrians are currently going without food, water or medical care and are in desperate need of humanitarian assistance and meanwhile, despite UN Security Council (UNSC) Resolution 2165 and subsequent resolutions authorising cross-border humanitarian assistance, the Syrian regime is reported to be continuing its obstruction of humanitarian aid in strategic areas.

What steps does the Council intend to take to ensure compliance by the Syrian regime with UNSC resolution provisions that allow cross-border humanitarian assistance?
