Subject: Destruction of wildlife habitat in Cameroon

Satellite images show that more than 3 000 hectares of rainforest bordering the Dja Faunal Reserve has already been destroyed inside the Chinese-owned Hevea Sud rubber and palm oil concession in Cameroon's South Region. The reserve is a UNESCO World Heritage site and home to the western lowland gorilla, chimpanzees and mandrills.

What measures will the Commission take to ensure that Cameroon takes steps towards more proper land-use planning in order to avoid negative effects on endangered wildlife species?
