Subject: French contribution sociale généralisée (CSG)

In response to a question submitted by Sir Graham Watson MEP (E-009844/2013) regarding the French *contribution sociale généralisée* (CSG), also known as the French double tax on second-home owners, the Commission stated:

'The Commission's services have formally registered an infringement against France. However, in the meantime the French Conseil d'État has referred a request to the Court of Justice for a preliminary ruling on the application of the Social Security Coordination Regulation as regards the levying of the CSG and CRDS, the outcome of which will determine further action by the Commission.'

Would the Commission provide an update on this situation? And will the Commission be taking further action to end this double social security contribution imposed on second-home owners?
