Subject: Quality standards for concrete products and construction fill material

Seeing as the European standard for concrete EN 206 is not harmonised, in the absence of CE marking regulations for concrete, as a material, under Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products, could the Commission indicate whether quality standards for concrete mix are governed by any other provisions in EU law?

Could the Commission further indicate what action it can take to ensure that minimum quality standards for concrete, concrete mix and construction fill material are enforced, irrespective of whether they are included as components of construction products falling under the scope of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011?

What is the Commission's assessment of the enforcement of standards for building products in Ireland, and how does the Commission ensure that these standards are met?
