Subject: Imported products manufactured using child labour to be labelled accordingly

In 2009, the European Parliament approved a report on the priority accorded to child protection in the EU's external actions, which suggested the introduction of labelling for imported products to confirm that they have been manufactured without the use of child labour. However, little or nothing has been done since.

1. What progress has the Commission made on this matter?
2. Is the Commission going to use its power of legislative initiative to propose a binding rule governing the labelling of imported products to confirm that they have been manufactured without the use of child labour? When will it be doing so?
