Subject: VP/HR - Israel obstructing the nuclear deal with Iran

During his recent visit to the United States, the Israeli Prime Minister, Benjamin Netanyahu, denounced the way that the United States is conducting the negotiations with Iran on the country's nuclear programme.

Does the High Representative consider the Israeli Government's attitude positive in the context of the negotiations on Iran's nuclear programme?

Does the High Representative believe that the attitude of Mr Netanyahu – who has stated that the deal 'paves Iran's path to the bomb' – is consistent with the fact that his country has nuclear weapons? Is the High Representative up-to-date with this situation?
