Question for written answer E-004433/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 José Blanco López (S&D)

Subject: The Erasmus programme in Galicia

According to the Commission's answer to my written question E-000339/2015 about the Erasmus programme, the EU average monthly grant for student mobility is EUR 272, which represents a 9 % increase on the EUR 250 of the previous year. This figure contrasts with the monthly grant of between EUR 80 and 150, depending on which country the students go to, that is offered by the Galician regional government.

In light of the answer to written question E-013461/2013, could the Commission update the information provided then on how many students have benefited from the Erasmus academic exchange programme with Galician universities as their point of origin or destination? Could it provide a breakdown of these figures by academic year, universities of origin and destination, and academic field? What annual percentage do they represent with respect to the total number of students at Galician universities, and what is the evolution of that figure? What is the average number of Erasmus students from Spain and from the EU as a whole, broken down by Member State?
