Subject: VP/HR - Attack in Tunis

The atrocities committed by ISIS, who struck again today with an attack on a museum in the city of Tunis, the repeated attacks in Libya and the terrorists' declared intention to reach Europe by any means necessary (including by concealing themselves amongst the crowds of migrants arriving from Africa) are among the most pressing issues facing Europe today.

In addition, these atrocities are occurring ever more frequently in northern Africa, and the risk of further attacks on European soil is increasing. The countries of northern Africa are now in grave danger, especially considering that they are unstable and thus less organised than they were prior to the so-called 'Arab Spring', which the EU fully supported, giving praise and encouragement to the rebels.

Can the High Representative confirm if she intends to report to Parliament? Does she not consider it important to implement not only a strong defence strategy for Europe but also measures to help neighbouring non-EU countries in which ISIS are active?
