Question for written answer E-004511/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Notis Marias (ECR)

Subject: Funds to restore damage caused to public infrastructure in Samothrace by the extreme

weather conditions

The heavy rainfall which hit the island of Samothrace on 7 and 8 March damaged every single rural road and caused a great deal of damage to technical works on roads, the road network, verges and, most importantly, the road network between Therma and Kipos in the north part of the island.

Serious subsidence was reported at several places on the island (Profitis Ilias, Lakkoma, Limnidi and Chora) and wells in the areas of Karyota, Therma and Makrylia-Xyropotamos sustained extensive damage.

In view of the above, will the Commission say what funds it intends to release and to what timetable for the purpose of:

- 1. full and immediate restoration of the damage to public infrastructure in Samothrace caused by the above extreme weather conditions and
- 2. construction of flood protection works in the area.
