Subject: How is the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions striving to be representative of the citizens of Europe?

The Commission has previously stated that it 'strives to be representative of the increasingly diverse European citizens it serves' (response to Written Questions E-008102/14, E-007850/14 and E-007851/14).

Does the Commission's view mirror that of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions (Eurofound)?

Could Eurofound provide 10 examples of such efforts in practice?
