Subject: Taxation and copyright

The European Commission's Internal Market and Services Directorate General recently released a report detailing the results of the public consultation on the reform of Directive 2001/29/EC, in which it was revealed that a large majority of the stakeholders interviewed not only believed in the necessity of copyright reforms, but also of other measures capable of facilitating cross-border supply and availability of digital content.
