Subject: Compulsory vaccination of children - impact on citizens' health

- 1. Does the Commission possess data on the practice of compulsory vaccination by Member States according to the type of vaccine and types of diseases?
- 2. Given the different practices of certain Member States, has there been an analysis or comparison of the effects of compulsory vaccination on the overall health of citizens and the control of infectious diseases in relation to the practice where it is not compulsory?
