Subject: Executions in Pakistan

In Pakistan, authorities have lifted a moratorium on executions and have begun executing prisoners convicted of terrorism-related charges.

In 2008, after the moratorium was introduced, Pakistan obtained a tax exemption on textile exports, which resulted in an increase in sales worth USD 1 billion.

Has the European Union taken a position on the re-establishment of the moratorium, such as reintroducing the tax on textile imports?
