Subject: Unanswered questions from the discussion with Frans Timmermans (First Vice-President of the Commission) at the EMPL Committee meeting

As Frans Timmermans (First Vice-President of the Commission) left some questions unanswered in the discussion at the EMPL Committee meeting on 24 March 2015, the Commission is requested to answer the following questions as quickly as possible:

1. What specific measures is the Commission planning to tackle wage dumping and social dumping in Europe?
2. In the light of the Commission's REFIT programme, the logic not merely of current projects but also of anticipated projects ought to be reviewed. In the case of the Commission's proposal for a single-member company (SUP), the consequences of introducing such a form of company go against the Commission's aim of combating tax evasion, bogus self-employment and social dumping. Will the SUP proposal now be withdrawn?
3. Letterbox companies not only provide opportunities for tax fraud, but also enable social security contributions and collective bargaining agreements to be circumvented. What plans does the Commission have to combat letterbox companies?
