Subject: State of actions against Mafia-related crime in the EU

In 2013, Europol published a report entitled 'Italian Organized crime threat assessment' on the overall mapping and goals of Italian organised crime at an international level from the law enforcement (LE) perspective.

In 2012, the first 'Special Parliamentary Committee of inquiry into Mafia-related and other criminal organisations' was established at the European Parliament.

1. Can the Commission provide information on what actions are currently being undertaken at European level to fight organised crime?
2. What measures is the Commission's Prevention of and Fight against Crime (ISEC) programme taking against the threat posed by Mafia-related crime to European citizens, the economy and institutions?
