Subject: VP/HR - Fight against racism and migration flows

On Saturday 21 March, on the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination, you stated that it was necessary to act forcefully to prevent and combat all forms of racism and xenophobia.

All the analyses show that uncontrolled migration flows give rise to feelings of rejection and xenophobia among indigenous populations.

Does the High Representative believe that, in order to combat racism and xenophobia effectively, we should also start to reverse migration flows to the European Union in the medium term by means of a policy of investment in the countries of origin?
