Subject: Frontex immigration report for Q3 2014

The European Agency for the Management of Operational Cooperation at the External Borders of the Member States of the European Union (Frontex) published its report on illegal immigration in Q3 2014 at the beginning of March. The figures are alarming to say the least. Between July and September, 110 581 crossings were recorded, bringing the total for the first nine months of 2014 to 200 852. This represents an increase of 150 % compared with the same period in 2013.

In view of the fact that the figures for illegal immigration continue to rise, what measures does the European Commission intend to take in order to stop illegal immigrants from entering the European Union?
