Subject: Support programme for countries subject to intervention by the troika (IMF-EU-ECB)

Having regard to the recent statements by the President of the European Commission, according to which the troika (IMF-EU-ECB) has undermined the dignity of the people of the countries in which it has intervened – Portugal, Greece and Ireland – we would like to ask the Commission:

1. What have been the practical consequences of these statements by its President? What has been the outcome, in practical terms, for the countries concerned?
2. Is it willing to support the creation of an aid programme to these countries, to repair the damage caused by the troika and, apart from financial transfers, provide, for example, exemptions from the functioning of the single market and community policies?
