Subject: Development cooperation in Moldova

The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), in performing its duties under EU law, has already in the past been the subject of criticism for having financed projects for which corruption investigations were under way. Since integrity is one of the non-negotiable values of the EU and the latter has signed an Association Agreement with Moldova, can the Commission answer the following questions:

1. Is it aware of the role played by the EBRD in the project relating to the port of Giurgiulești, the ownership of which is currently in dispute?
2. If so, what does it intend to do?
3. How does the Commission promote the EU's basic principles in international agreements?
