Subject: Organ trafficking

Trafficking in human organs, tissues and cells for the purpose of organ replacement is a problem of global proportions that violates basic human rights and constitutes a direct threat to individual and public health.

What is the current situation as regards adoption and implementation of the Council of Europe Draft Convention against Trafficking in Human Organs?

Is the EU going to support training and orientation programmes for law enforcement agencies and for medical staff who could be involved in committing offences in this regard?

Is it going to support programmes aimed at raising awareness of this vulnerable sector, both before and after the offences are committed?
