Subject: Clarification of the procedure for ratifying the TTIP

We would like to ask the Commission a few questions regarding the ratification of the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership.

As this is a 'mixed' agreement, it is generally accepted that, besides the European Parliament, each of the Member States will, in turn, need to ratify the agreement.

What would happen if one or more Member States refused to ratify this treaty? Would it lead to its definitive rejection?
