Subject: Evaluation of measures adopted in the outermost regions to consolidate the EU's single market

The measures adopted by the European Union to consolidate a single market are still producing scarce results in overcoming the obstacles faced by the outermost regions (ORs) due to their particular circumstances.

Although specific measures have been adopted to compensate for the structural difficulties facing the ORs, barriers still exist that hinder or impede the free movement of people, goods, services and capital within the single market, of which the ORs form part for all effects and purposes.

Has the Commission considered the possibility of carrying out a general evaluation of the measures adopted in the ORs to consolidate the EU's single market, with a view to taking such decisions as may be required to correct or extend them, as appropriate?
