Subject: Status of the implementation of the EU's Cross-border Cooperation (CBC) Programme

2007-2013 between Slovenia and Croatia

In my oral and written questions to the former European Commissioner for Regional Development, Mr Johannes Hahn, I repeatedly pointed out problems in the management of the EU's 2007-2013 Programme of Cross-border Cooperation between Slovenia and Croatia, which is creating financial difficulties for users of these funds in the county of Istria in Croatia.

I was recently again informed of long delays in the reimbursement of resources already spent, for example in REVITAS as well as in some other projects; this is creating a huge financial burden for smaller local government units and a need for additional borrowing, thus reducing the effects of project implementation. Specifically, we are talking about a three-year delay in reimbursement from when the activities were carried out.

- 1. Is the Commission aware of the problems involved in the management of this programme?
- 2. What measures is the Commission planning to take to help solve the problems of managing this programme and accelerate the reimbursement of the resources spent?
