Subject: Identification of livestock production methods

Factory farming is usually characterised by keeping animals in small inappropriate cages or in unsuitable conditions, instead of allowing them to live freely in conditions as close as possible to their natural environments. This cultivation method certainly has consequences for animals as well as for human consumption of food produced in this way. In the European Union only eggs are at present labelled as to whether, for example, laying hens lived in a cage or in the open.

Is the Commission considering the possibility of introducing production labelling for all animal produce used for human consumption, which would certainly raise the level of consumer awareness?
