Subject: Refugee camps

According to Save the Children, at least 3 500 children are trapped in the Yarmouk Palestinian refugee camp and are in danger of being harmed or killed.

In addition, it appears that dozens of medical volunteers, aid workers and civilians have been kidnapped, injured or killed and that many are still missing.

Islamic State (ISIS) jihadists are known to be in control of about 80 % of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, where living conditions are deteriorating dramatically, with reports of children being abducted for the harvesting of their organs.

What specific measures is the Commission taking in response to the tragic situation in the refugee camps of the Middle East?
