Subject: Cyber security

The cyber-attack on 8 April against the French-language television channel TV5 Monde and that which targeted several French-language Belgian newspapers showed once again the vulnerability of Europe's systems to cyber-attack.

The European Union urgently needs a comprehensive strategy to counter these threats as the number of cyber-attacks continues to rise.

In February 2013, the Commission adopted a Cyber Security Strategy to protect the EU's critical infrastructure, but that strategy has still not entered into force.

- 1. What powers does the EU have in the areas of cyber security and cyber defence? What progress has been made in implementing the EU's Cyber Security Strategy?
- 2. Is the Commission planning to propose new measures to protect all European IT systems?
- 3. What types of measures could be implemented to give the EU effective tools to counter these threats?
