Subject: Climate change and the Paris Summit

The European Commission Communication, 'The Paris Protocol – A blueprint for tackling global climate change beyond 2020', points to some essential features that will be part of Europe's negotiating mandate for the important multilateral Paris summit on climate change. These include guaranteeing that action to combat climate change is in line with the United Nations Millennium Development Goals, and that the promotion of an ambitious global environment policy is central in Europe's dialogue with partner countries.
