Subject: Youth Guarantee

In a report published on 24 March, the European Court of Auditors identifies three factors liable to hinder implementation of the Youth Guarantee in the EU: the adequacy of total funding, the definition of a 'good-quality offer' and the way the Commission monitors and reports the results of the scheme.

What urgent action is the Commission planning to take to address these substantial concerns within the framework of the expected new measures concerning the Youth Guarantee?
