Subject: VP/HR - Schools destroyed in Gaza

A report by a United Nations (UN) Committee of Enquiry that was published this week states that the Israeli army was responsible for seven attacks on UN-owned schools during its offensive against the Gaza Strip in the summer of 2014.

According to the report, these attacks left at least 44 people dead and 227 wounded between 16 July and 26 August, a time when the schools were operating as shelters for Palestinian civilians.

In view of this further irrefutable evidence of the crimes perpetrated by the Israeli army, I would ask the High Representative what conclusions she intends to draw from the results of this impartial report, specifically in relation to the various cooperation agreements that the EU has with the Israeli Government.
