Subject: EU aid for Nepal

The catastrophe in Nepal is one of the worst that the international community has suffered in recent years. It is estimated that the earthquake has affected more than 8 million people. The forecast is that the number of deaths will exceed 10 000, while hundreds of thousands of survivors need urgent humanitarian assistance.
