Subject: PCE/PEC - Summit between the President of the European Council and Petro Poroshenko

A meeting took place on 27 April 2015 in Kiev between President Tusk and Petro Poroshenko at which there was discussion of a number of aspects of the implementation of the Ukraine-EU Association Agreement. It is common knowledge that the EU's association agreements with other States can only be concluded if the other party proves their democratic and human rights credentials.

Did President Tusk discuss the situation of the Ukrainian Communist Party with Mr Poroshenko?

Was any mention made of the current status of the investigations into the Odessa massacre on 2 May 2014 in which over 40 people died? According to a number of observers, the judicial proceedings are at a standstill.

Was there any discussion at the summit of the language, cultural and political rights of Ukraine's Russian population?
