Subject: Earthquake in Nepal

On 25 April, Nepal was struck by a major earthquake measuring 7.8 on the Richter scale. In the following days, around fifty aftershocks occurred. According to some sources, the earthquake caused the death of over 5 000 people and much infrastructure was destroyed, both in the capital Kathmandu and in remote villages. It is also estimated that the earthquake has left almost 500 000 people homeless.

- 1. Could the Commission provide details of the emergency measures that have been taken to help the Nepalese people?
- 2. Does the Commission envisage providing long-term aid?
- 3. If so, what measures might be taken to support the rebuilding of the country?
