Subject: Concern about the investigation into ENVC - military construction

Given the position announced today by the Commission in a press release on 'state aid' to the Portuguese shipyard operator Estaleiros Navais de Viana do Castelo S.A. (ENVC), which has been found to be incompatible with EU rules, and since the text of the decision has not been released, which prevents detailed public scrutiny, can the Commission say whether, during the more than two years that the investigation lasted, the Portuguese State at any point invoked the interest of the construction of military vessels (which is not mentioned in the Commission's press release) and the special framework and treatment this should be granted?
