Subject: Fulfilment of the obligations from Directive 2007/60/EC

The wave of floods which in 2014 hit several countries of southeast Europe, among them Croatia, has had disastrous consequences for the population and areas affected by the floods. Along with other members of the European Union Croatia has adopted Directive 2007/60/EC on the assessment and management of flood risks. The duties of states prescribed by that directive include the assessment of flood risk, the mapping of danger and risk of flooding and taking appropriate and coordinated measures to remove the flood risk by 2015.

I ask the Commission:

1. In what way does the Commission monitor the fulfilment of the obligations of Member States stipulated by that directive?
2. Can the Commission confirm that the competent institutions in Croatia have brought the laws into line and successfully adopted and are implementing all of the procedures and practices prescribed by the directive in order to prevent and remediate flooding on Croatian territory as effectively as possible?
