Subject: Differences in the tax position of Danish pensioners resident in France

I have been made aware by a citizen that Danish pensioners who have their place of residence in France experience significant differences in the tax position of pension payments, depending on which department is dealing with the matter. The treatment in the Département du Var (Draguignan) differs particularly because of an extremely restrictive approach, which is detrimental to pensioners.

Will the Commission therefore state whether it believes the significant differences in the treatment of the tax situation of EU citizens within an EU Member State to be consistent with EU law?
