Subject: National consultation on immigration and terrorism in Hungary

The government of Viktor Orbán in Hungary, a Member State of the European Union, is currently consulting the people of Hungary on immigration and terrorism, via a 12-point questionnaire (*Le Figaro*, Tuesday, 19 May 2015).

Hungary is the EU country with the second-largest number of asylum seekers per head of population, which has prompted its government to hold this consultation.

1. Does the Commission support this Hungarian government initiative?
2. Does the Commission believe that initiatives allowing the citizens of Member States to give their opinions on immigration questions are useful?
3. Will the Commission encourage the other Member States to hold similar immigration consultations?
